GRAD NIGHT PARTY (REGISTRATION DETAILS)

DATE: June 12th (10pm) - June 13th (6am)

REGISTRATION TIME - Approximately 9:45pm (after graduation, family congratulations and photos).

DEPARTURE LOCATION - Safeco Field (see Registration Steps below).

DEPARTURE TIME - By 10:45pm

ATTIRE

- T-shirts are included in the cost of the grad party ticket. You will be required to change into your t-shirt after graduation near the grad party registration location.
- Casual attire is encouraged as there will be many activities for which you will want to be comfortable. Ask
 a family member to bring a bag to hold clothes for you until immediately after graduation and family
 photos. Parents/family will need to bring bags, clothing, cap and gown and personal belongings
 home with them. All entertainment details will not be disclosed, but the party will include physical activity
 opportunities such as dancing and inflatables.

REGISTRATION STEPS - Upon arriving at the Main Concourse after graduation and family photos, please follow these steps in order:

- Pick up T-shirt at tables behind Section 119.
- Change into t-shirt and comfortable clothing in restrooms (located next to t-shirt tables).
- **Give Parents/Guardians all items**: graduation cap, gown, graduation clothing, keys, wallets, cell phones and other items (e.g. graduation cards, flowers, gifts, etc...). Otherwise, personal items will be put in Ziploc bags and stored in boxes under the bus until the next morning.
- Check in at the registration tables (marked by bus color) behind Section 114. Here you will do the following:
 - Check-in with registration volunteers
 - Sign Party Agreement if over age 18
 - Get colored wristband for assigned bus
- Exit Safeco via Right Field Gate Exit located near Section 114.
- Go to Security Check and buses via crosswalk at corner of 1st Avenue South and Edgar Martinez Drive. Buses will be located across the street from Safeco Field (next to parking garage on Occidental Avenue South).

LEAVE_ALL ITEMS WITH PARENTS/GUARDIANS - Graduates may not bring anything with them to the party (other than pre-approved medication). Cell phones are NOT allowed at the Grad Night Party. We promise, you will not want or need cell phones as there will be so much going on and your friends will be with you. Party chaperones will provide photography. Pictures will be made available to Liberty's Class of 2015 via a separate photo link.

MEDICATION - In the event you need to bring medication or Epi-Pen, please put it in a Ziploc bag and write the graduate's name with a black Sharpie. We will keep medication with our medical chaperone, unless previously approved for graduate to carry on their person.

SECURITY CHECK - ALL graduates will go through a pat down at the security check location, prior to boarding their assigned bus. Deputy Dave Montalvo will be at the buses to ensure no graduate has been drinking or using drugs. **This is a drug and alcohol free event.** We promise a fun, safe, activity filled, and memorable experience for the Class of 2015!

TRANSPORTATION - Charter buses are included in the price of the party ticket. All seniors/graduates attending the party, **MUST** ride the bus to and from the party venues and back to Liberty High School.

VENUE LOCATIONS - Undisclosed! It's top secret until they arrive at each venue.

VENUE ENTERTAINMENT AND FOOD - The venues are packed with entertainment, activities, prizes and food!

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY - A phone number will be provided for parents in the event of a family emergency. In the event of illness or injury, graduates will be allowed to use a chaperone's phone.

ARRIVAL AT LIBERTY (**POST PARTY**) - Students need to be picked up at Liberty by 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 13th. Students must **NOT** drive themselves as they will be EXHAUSTED! We do NOT want graduates on the road in a tired state. It is recommended that you coordinate carpool pick-up ahead of time.
